

# LAW OF MONGOLIA ON FREEDOM OF MEDIA

August 28, 1998

Ulaanbaatar

## **Article 1. The purpose of the law**

1.1. The purpose of this law is to guarantee the rights of Mongolian citizens, stipulated in the Constitution of Mongolia, to freely express opinions, speak and publish.

## **Article 2. Freedom of Media**

2.1. The State Ikh Khural of Mongolia is prohibited to adopt any law, which limits freedom of media and independency of media outlets.

## **Article 3. Prohibition of Control on Media**

3.1. Media outlets organizations should bear the responsibility for the information published and broadcasted by them. The State shall not control or censor the content of public information.

3.2. The State shall not establish organizations to monitor the information that is published and broadcasted by media outlets nor finance it.

## **Article 4. Prohibition on State media organizations**

4.1. State bodies are prohibited to have their own media organizations.
